You might even imagine a motion picture super hero at the wheel.



Painted Silverstar Silver and Crystal Black, this awesome beauty is in fact a custom-built retro rod that's modeled after the classic 1937 Ford Hardtop. Originally built in Sparks, Nevada this Cool Ride proudly makes its home in the West Valley...

As it "poses" in the Arizona late afternoon sunlight, its flowing and sculptured body lines demand your attention.

Upfront, 18" polished American Torque Thrust Wheels grab your attention, with 20" look-a-likes at the rear.


Today, this '37 is valued in a price range of \$75,000-\$100,000.
